

ORDINANCE #24

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK WITHIN
THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF EAST CAMDEN, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAST
CAMDEN, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That is is hereby declared a misdemeanor
for any person that keeps within the City Limits of the
City of East Camden any hogs, cows, horses, goats, sheep, *nowhere*,
mules, chickens, turkeys, donkeys, shetland ponies, snakes,
and any other animals that can be deemed a health hazard
or offensive in odor to the persons living near said animals.

Section 2. Persons found guilty shall be fined in any
sum not less than \$5.00 or more than \$25.00 and shall be
ordered to remove the animal from the City Limits of the
City of East Camden, Arkansas, within twenty-four (24)
hours after being found guilty of the offense.

Section 3. Each day a person keeps an animal within
the City Limits of the City of East Camden, Arkansas, after
being found guilty of this misdemeanor, shall be considered
a separate offense and may be so charged under the provisions
of this ordinance.

Section 4. An emergency is therefore declared and this
ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage.
